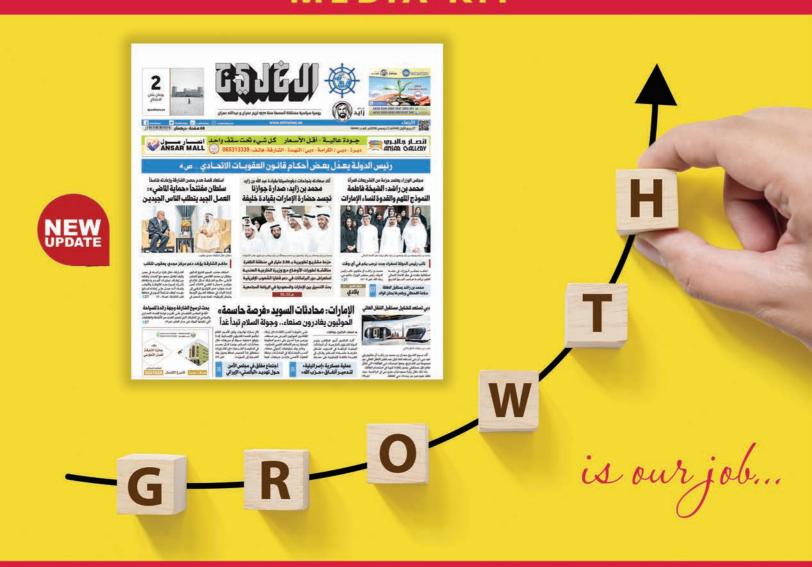

الاقتصادية Business Section

In a country where economic activity is of crucial importance, the Business section of Al Khaleej has contributed significantly to the development of the national economy, Initially the section merely covered news of economic authorities, departments and chambers of commerce across the UAE on a few dedicated pages. Now it is an integrated supplement of multiple chapters & diverse services.

The section is edited by tens of sub-editors, financial analysts and specialists. The 36-page daily supplement of Al Khaleej Business incorporates many dedicated daily pages concerned with local, Arab and international financial and stock markets.

Al Khaleej Business tracks the daily events and news of the stock movements in the local, GCC and international financial markets. Specialists contribute these reports. These provide services related to the daily prices of local stocks and the most significant GCC, Arab & international indices.

In addition, AI Khaleej Business provides exchange rates of currencies and the prices of gold, silver and other metals in the local market, not to mention the oil prices and the rates of currencies and metals in the international markets.

Al Khaleej Business also handles news on national and foreign companies operating within the crucible of the national economy. It provides a platform for people who lead these companies to appear on its pages to present their vision and ideas by means of regular interviews dealing with all the updates of companies and their responses to what is happening in the markets.



Al Khaleej claims four decades of glorious history. Launched on Monday, October 19, 1970, it has achieved phenomenal growth, from a tiny eight-page product to a 120-plus page newspaper with a sweeping coverage of national and international news every day.

The newspaper was a mission for its dynamic and proven leaders, the late Taryam Omran Taryam and his brother Dr Abdullah Omran Taryam, who felt the need to fill the gap in the print media in a region that was lacking after years of British occupation.

For the leaders, the mission was crystal clear: to defend all Arab and Emirati issues and to support the rights of people everywhere. They advocated strong positions to fulfill the mission.

The paper has progressed with the country. Growing into a market leader in the region, the Al Khaleej now has set up offices in a number of Arab cities, including Cairo, Beirut, Muscat, Amman, Khartoum, Damascus, Sana'a, Rabat, Kuwait, Doha, Manama, and in the Palestinian state.

A network of correspondents report for the newspaper from several continents, in cities as far away as Washington, Moscow, London and Paris. News of every kind is covered: political, economic, sport, entertainment.

The 120 pages of the newspaper is divided into four parts, Al Khaleej 1, Al Khaleej 2, Al Khaleej Business and Al Khaleej Sports.

Sports Section

Sports reflect the youth of the newspaper. A mega team of 25 reporters specialised in various sports works to make this section vibrant. The team is located at the newspaper's headquarters in Sharjah, besides the offices in various emirates and also in other Arab countries.

Specialists, analysts and authors work to enrich the section through reports, special coverage and weekly articles.

During seasons, the section issues a daily appendix of 16-20 pages, making the coverage sweeping.

The newspaper's message remains intact, and the reader's mind and the objectivity of topics are respected. Priority is given to national issues and topics that appeal to the public, and they are supported in their bid to achieve their goals.

The sport appendix addresses all classes of society and covers all sports and athletics, especially the traditional ones. Among them are equestrian and camel racing, in addition to other games.



The Cultural Supplement

The journey of the "Cultural Supplement" in "Al Khaleej" started in the early eighties of the last century. During this long period, it has witnessed a series of changes to cope with change itself. The supplement thrived throughout its various phases and has launched a number of names, currently devoted to the Emirati cultural scene. It has attracted a number of distinguished writers from Arab countries. The supplement follows up various cultural events locally and regionally.



Al Siha Wateb Magazine

Al Siha Wateb Magazine is more of a magazine than a supplement. It consists of 84 pages, which highlights healthy and useful food and ways to prevent diseases. It simplifies the understanding of latest techniques and methods of treatment in the world of medical science.

This section follows the affairs of the Emirati and Arab family through cases, which focus on discussing the most important and current social issues. This is done with the help for specialists,

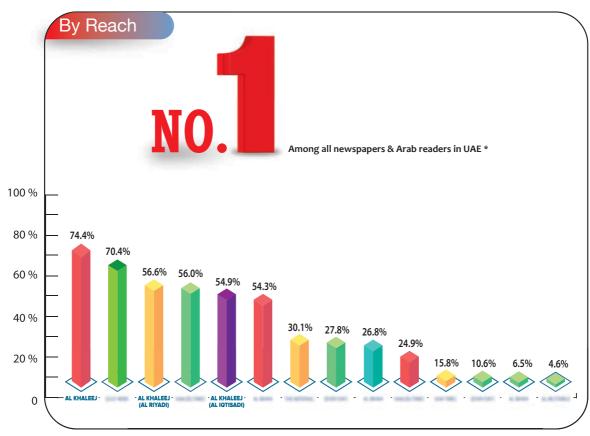
who provide files and investigations that reach

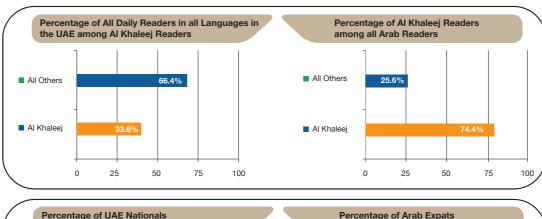
Pages on "religion for life" come within the appendix, which present prominent Muslim sheikhs to explain various religious topics and put them in the national perspective.

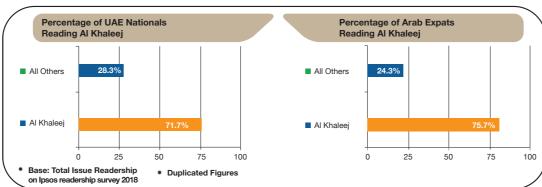


Penetration



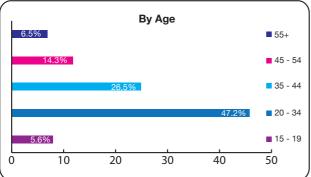
